- Essential Bible Dictionary: Short answers to questions you may have about essential people, places, events, and themes of the Bible.
- Introduction to the Bible; A Catholic Guide to Studying Scripture: Catholics are often reluctant to begin reading the Bible because of a lack of understanding of how to do so. This author offers practical explanations that will make the Bible less foreign and more familiar.
- 25 Windows into the Soul; Praying with the Psalms: This book can be the start of a life of prayer that brings peace and faith and reflection and wisdom to the chaos of daily life.
- The Acts of the Apostles: This book has an accompanying video presentation that explores the struggles of the early Christian believers to establish communities of faith—struggles surprisingly like those today.
- Women in the Old Testament: This book also has an accompanying video that shares stories of women in the past that are vital to the revelation of God's relationship with the Israelites.
