

Adult session on Solidarity:

6:55 – All together in church (total 25 min)

- Intro into video and question handout:
  - What do you see as important topics from video.
  - Bothersome/unsettling topics from video
  - How did video make you feel?
- Show video (13 min)
- Participants discuss questions with person(s) around them (5 min) and then bring comments to larger group.
- From this discussion bring out: Understanding of Solidarity, Where do you see Solidarity taking place?

7:20 – Input on Catholic Social Teaching (total 12-15)

- Where does Solidarity fit into picture of CST
- Solidarity as seen as virtue / how do we nurture this virtue
- Quotes USCCB and Pope Benedict and Pope John Paul II

7:35 – Bringing it home...

- Where do you see the challenge of living Solidarity out in society today?
- After a minute of private thought ask them to again join with others next to them to discuss this question.
- Feedback from group / focusing on certain aspects, like stereotyping, lack of placing oneself in another's shoes, not seeing a connectedness among people, etc.
- Bring it home to them in daily surroundings.
