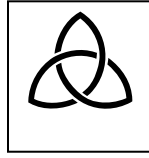


Home Activity Directions

Contents(NB: all contents provided for in a plastic bag for each family)

1 paper plate
½ sheet of paper with Trinity symbols
3 pieces of colored yarn (3 different colors)
1 feather (Spirit)
1 cross (Son)
1 heart (Father)

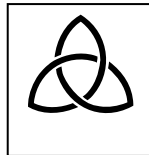


- Cut out Trinity symbols
- Glue one on each side of the paper plate
- Cut the three pieces of yarn in half (one different one for each bottom hole; all three colors together for hanging.)
- Tie a different color of yarn to each of the three hole closest together (top hole is to hang with).
- Attach one of the symbols to the bottom of one piece of yarn. Repeat with the other symbols. As you do this, share with your family words or images that come to mind as you reflect on each member of the Trinity.
- Now gather the remaining three pieces of yarn and attach them together into the top hole of the plate. Tie together to other end and hang
- Hang in a place where it will be a visible reminder to all members of the family to include prayer to the Triune God in their daily routine.
