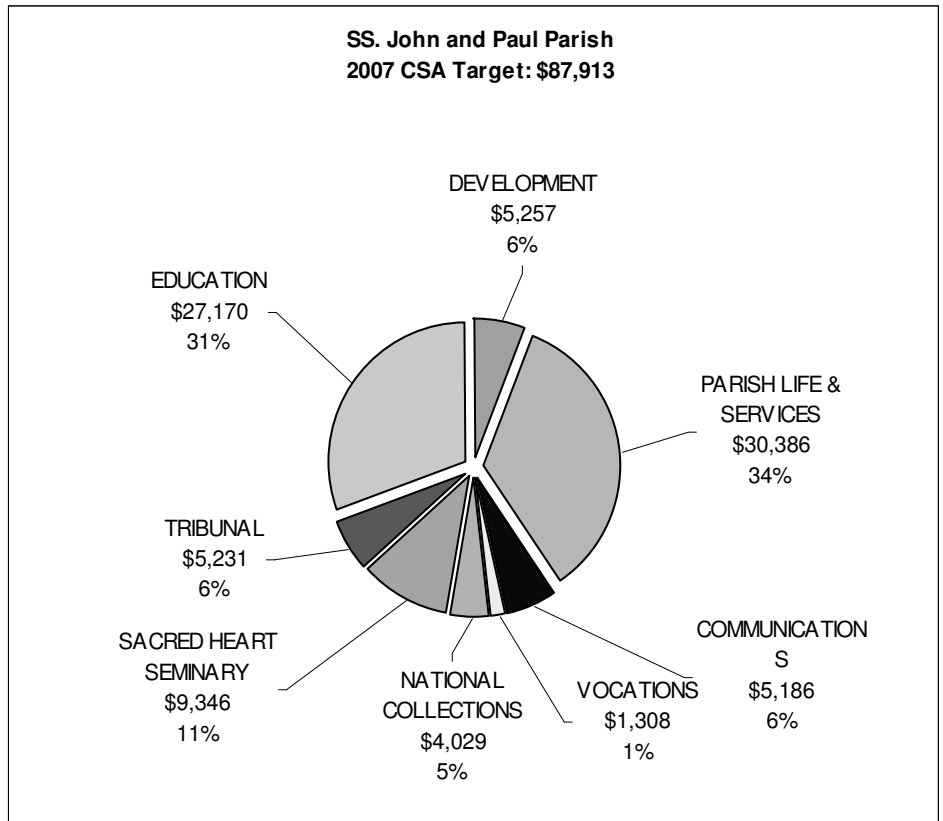

## Your C.S.A. Dollars at Work

This year the parish goal for the 2007 Catholic Services Appeal is \$87,913. Did you know that our C.S.A. pledges support the following Archdiocesan ministries:

- ◆ **Sacred Heart Major Seminary:** candidates for the priesthood (22 men were ordained for the Archdiocese of Detroit over the past five years), candidates for permanent diaconate, lay students in the Institute for Ministry and student scholarships. **Our 2007 contribution: \$9,346**
- ◆ **Vocations:** discernment and junior high vocation awareness. **Our 2007 contribution: \$1,308**

- ◆ **Metropolitan Tribunal:** Marriage Annulments and presentations at parishes. **Our 2007 contribution: \$5,231**
- ◆ **National Collections:** (these are collections that the parishes are not asked to contribute to; all donations to these collections come from C.S.A. dollars): Black and Indian Missions, Catholic Communication Campaign, Catholic University of America, Church in Latin America, and Holy Land. **Our 2007 contribution: \$4,029**
- ◆ **Development:** Christian Stewardship Education and Planned Giving. **Our 2007 contribution: \$5,257**
